TAE50111 Diploma of VET Practicum notes

All TAE50111 candidates need access to a learning and assessment environment where they can access information and apply their skills.

It is important when considering this aspect of delivery to remember the requirements of the three core units provisions intended to underpin an evidence route that supports a **'pracitcum' in practice**.

The critical aspects of evidence for the units of competency covered in this holistic assessment task include some specific requirements for evidence. These are:

TAEPDD501A Maintain and enhance professional practice	Collect, document and discuss with peers evidence of feedback from at least 10 hours of facilitation practice and interviews with assessors covering at least the assessment of 10 candidates.
TAEDEL502A Provide advanced facilitation practice	A minimum of 100 hours of group facilitation. <i>“facilitate and provide evidence of at least 30 hours of group learning after the commencement of the Diploma of VET and obtain feedback from peers or other VET practitioners and learners of at least ten hours of these 30 “</i>
TAEASS501A Provide advanced assessment practice	Undertake the assessment of at least 20 individual candidates from a total of at least 50 units of competency from training packages or accredited courses. Lead assessment among a group or team of assessors, consisting of at least five individuals and demonstrate how that leadership has lead to improved processes and outcomes. <i>“assess and provide evidence of at least ten candidates against a total of 20 units of competency after the commencement of the Diploma of VET”.</i>
